CRUISE CHECK-IN

Begins usually around 1:00 pm, depending on how the debarkation of the previous cruise goes. However, you will not be able to go to the cabins until the afternoon, as they will need to finish cleaning them. Usually there is an announcement on board when you can go to your cabin. You can drop your luggage off to the cruise porters once the debarkation process is over. For this sailing you must be on board 90 minutes prior to sailing, or by 7:00 pm.

To get from the airport to San Juan, you can take a taxi, public bus or car rental. Cruise ships dock right in the heart of Old San Juan, which dates back to the 16th century. It is about 11 miles from the airport to Old San Juan, about 9 miles from the airport to the Sheraton.

RCCL BUS SHUTTLE SERVICE OFFERED FEBRUARY 26 AND MARCH 4, 2012

Purchase of transfers can be done through Sundancer. You will need to provide your flight information at the time of purchase. Flight details are provided to the transportation company to assist in expediting your transfer to the pier. It is your responsibility to update Sundancer with any changes to your flight schedule to ensure you are met by the transportation company.

Cost of Transfers:

Between San Juan Airport and Port

One Way: \$16.75. Or Round Trip: \$33.50

Transfer rates are subject to change and any unused services are nonrefundable.

Flight Guidelines

To use this service your flights must follow the following guidelines

Arrive by 6:00 p.m. on 2/26/12

We return to the port about 6:00 a.m. on 3/4/12. However it typically takes about 2 hours to disembark. Note for return bus shuttles they recommend your flight depart San Juan after 11:00 a.m.

Prior to your cruise you will be met at the airport: You will be met and assisted by meet & greet service in the baggage claim area and then escorted to your vehicle for transfer to the port.

Sundancer did inquire with several companies regarding a private shuttle on March 4th, but by the time gratuities and baggage fees were added the price was nearly the same as Royal Caribbean's shuttle (who has no fees for luggage or excess luggage). Therefore if you would like to book this shuttle please contact Sundancer at 866-409-7245 (SAIL), preferable by **January 25, 2012.**

TAXICABS

Another option would be to share taxis. There is a taxi kiosk when you step outside the airport building. The attendant at the kiosk will give you the exact price and will write it down for the taxi driver (however a fuel charge of \$1.50 may be added)

There are apparently two types of taxis in San Juan, Touristic Cabs and Regular Cabs. Touristic Cabs charge by the zone and number of bags, and Regular Cabs are metered. Here is the website link showing fares and what additional fees may apply. Typically the tip is 10-15%. <http://www.cabspr.com/>
